

SURBITON PARKS AND GREENS

What you'll see

Berrylands, the Hogsmill River and Alexandra Park with its 16.5 acres, playground, bowling and croquet lawns. The park is also home to Alexandra Millennium Green, built to mark the turn of the millennium for community use and to encourage wildlife on the site of the derelict allotments. (7 miles)

- A** Starting at the clock tower on Claremont Road, join The Crescent adjacent to the mirrored building.
- B** Before the zebra crossing turn left into Endsleigh Gardens and right to Victoria Park. Dismount and walk your cycle by the railway embankment.
- C** At the end of Lovelace Road cross over to Walpole Road then turn right up Oak Hill Grove. At the top turn left, first right then right into Oak Hill Crescent.
- D** Turn right and go down the hill in the bus lane, turning left into Fishponds Park. Take the road through the park and leave via a gravel path at the top of an incline.
- E** Turn right into Stirling Walk.
- F** Take the subway under the A3.
- G** Turn right from Manor Drive, and then turn right, left, right and left through to South Lane.
- H** Take the subway under the A3.
- I** Turn right down towards Berrylands railway station and through to Lower Marsh Lane.
- J** At the junction with Villiers Road turn right and then immediately left at the mini roundabout.
